Synonyms

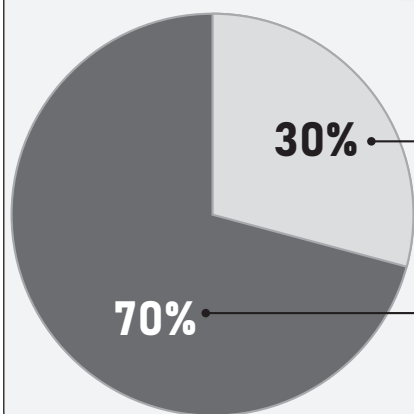
